Josefa's mother was a drug addict and a prostitute in Nicaragua. When she was a baby, her mother abandoned her. Thankfully, Josefa's grandmother reached out and chose to raise this precious girl. Generous gifts from friends of Feed the Hungry helped start a feeding program in Josefa's neighborhood when she was 8 years old. As Josefa received hot, nutritious meals, she learned about God's incredible love and grace for her. After receiving her first Bible, she invited Christ into her life. Though the next few years were filled with struggle, Josefa continued to grow in her faith. She began a church for children in her community, meeting at the feeding center where Josefa ate her first rice meal. She mobilized a number of children to share the Gospel on the streets of her community, training them in the Word and in worship. In 2017, Josefa began working alongside the Feed the Hungry team in Nicaragua, traveling and sharing her testimony about the power of a hot meal and the love of God.

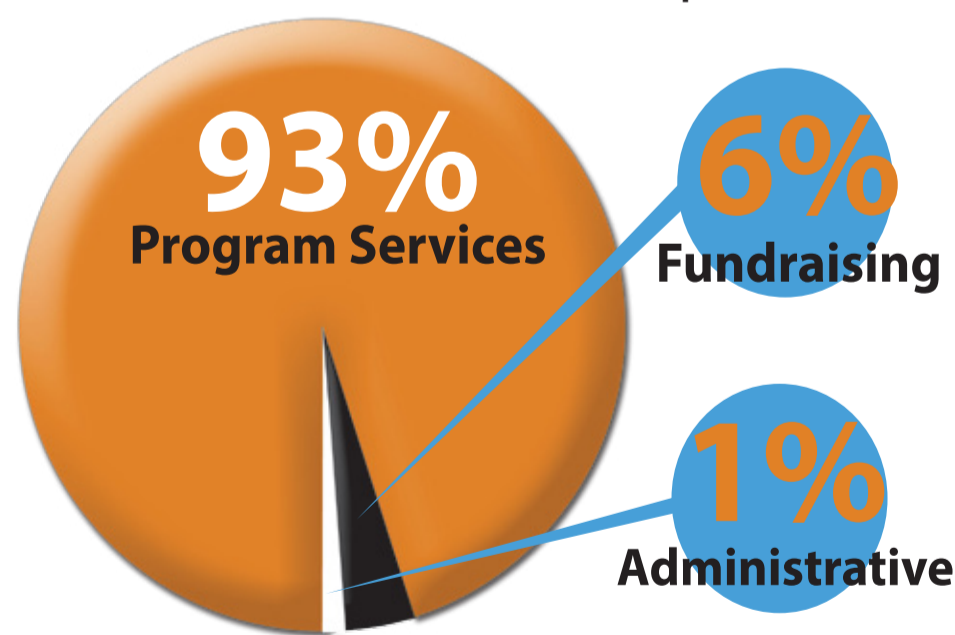
2.5 million pounds of water and emergency supplies delivered through local church partners to those affected by Hurricanes Harvey and Irma, and tropical storms



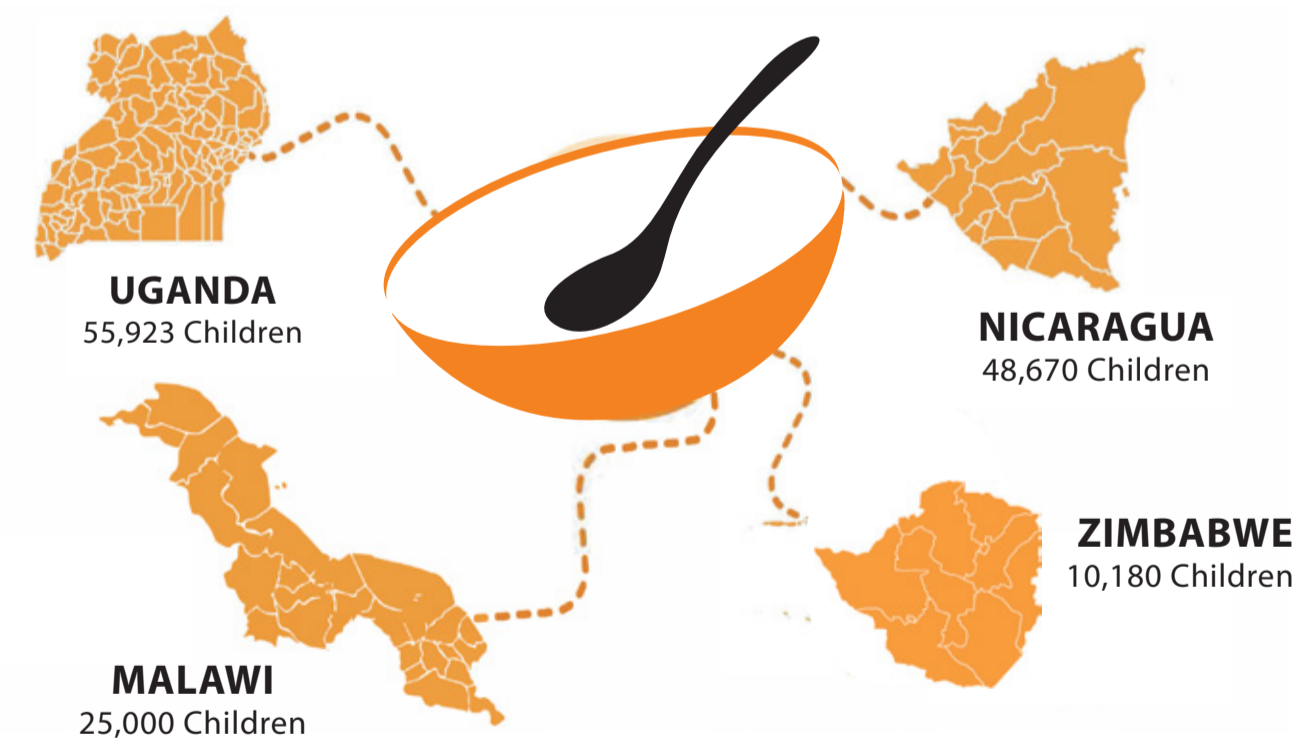
